Project #2 Transforming a Million Homes In Africa

Global Children's Network (GCN) is actively discipling over one million children and teens in thirty countries on the continent of Africa. We do this according to Dr. Jack Eggar by training pastors to train parents to disciple their children at home and church together. GCN has also expanded their Malachi Kid's Club ministry platform to 1400 public schools. Is it possible to train children at church and school to take home Bible stories and their truths and share them with their parents? Pastors and churches will embrace this bold outreach strategy by encouraging kids and youth to go and tell God's story.

Our 2026-27 project includes funding more 150cc motorcycles for GCN missionaries (\$2,000 for one new motorcycle), expanding Malachi Kid's School Clubs from 6 countries to 12 countries, and the development and distribution of home training tools for the parents.

PROJECT #1 CHRISTIAN SCHOOLS IN PAKISTAN

In Pakistan there are almost 20,000 brick kiln factories that put children as young as six years old to work, six long days every week. Thousands of children serve as bonded workers to help pay off the generational debt their illiterate parents or grandparents incurred by borrowing needed money from the brick kiln owners. The problem is that with high interest rates, even minuscule loans can never be repaid.

Here's how the system works:

Non-muslims struggle to find employment and often end up with the least desirable jobs that also pay very little. They are encouraged to take out loans from brick kiln owners to cover basic needs. Families can never repay the debt that only increases year after year. It gets passed down to the next generation and parents have no choice but to commit their children to perpetual slavery.

Rev. Yousaf and his team's solution is to bring the gospel of Jesus Christ into every brick kiln worker's home, plant house churches, and provide a small Christian school to begin the modern-day exodus from slavery. You won't want to miss Rev. Yousaf's story!

WHAT DO WE DO

We train and equip pastors, parents, and local church volunteers to effectively build a bridge from the church into the home. We call this the

Pastor + Parent Partnership = Next Generation Discipleship

Pastors see themselves as both "shepherd and "captain" of their congregation. Pastors train and commission the parents to become active in the homes, encouraging and engaging their children in spiritual conversations.

Youth pastors teach and commission teens and kids in Malachi Kids Clubs to initiate conversations with their parents so that homes grow and flourish in the Lord, thus fulfilling what the Bible teaches in Deuteronomy 6:6-7:

"And these words which I command you this day shall be upon your heart; and you shall teach them diligently to your children and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise."
